THE RESIDENCE RIGHT OF FOREIGN CITIZENS IN PORTUGAL REMAINS VALID FOR UP TO 6 MONTHS AFTER THE EXPIRY DATE OF THE RESIDENCE PERMIT CARD, PROVIDED THAT NO ANNULMENT, REVOCATION, OR TERMINATION DECISION HAS BEEN ISSUED.

SPECIFIC DEADLINES

Residence cards expired by 30 June 2025:

➤ Remain valid until 15 April 2026.

Residence cards expiring after 30 June 2025:

➤ Remain valid for six months after the expiry date.

Already submitted your renewal request?

In this case, you must carry both the <u>expired residence card</u> and <u>the receipt confirming submission</u> to AIMA.

RESTRICTIONS

Legal Grace Period

The 6-months period does not constitute a new residence title, but a legal grace period allowing lawful stay in Portugal.

Renewal Request

Renewal requests must be submitted within six months from expiry to maintain legal status.

Portuguese Territory

This right is valid only within Portuguese territory and does not grant Schengen mobility.

What if...?

After that period, renewal is no longer admissible. A new residence application must be filed.
